One year and a half has passed, but in Italy there still is the Bossi-Fini law.

The Government had undertaken some important pledges for immigrants, but these promises haven't been kept yet.

For nearly two years immigrants and their families have been paying hundreds of euros in order to renew their residence permit, but they have to wait many months.

We have to renew our residence permit any time we change our job, when a child is born, when we change our address or our passport...

In the last few months the campaigns which foment the hostility against immigrants have grown stronger and they ask for new repressive laws.

Unfortunately we have to observe that lately there aren't only the usual racist forces, but also some mayors and politicians from centre-left.

We immigrants work in factories, cooperatives, houses, for little money and with few rights; and our life conditions are getting worse.

We have to rally again, **ALL TOGETHER**, more than before and with a stronger determination.
